Grapevine Bass Anglers 2007

We had another good turnout for our April event with twenty anglers making the trip to Bob Sandlin. Lake conditions were improved since our last trip to this lake but it was still about 7 ft low and water temps were typically in the 59 to 61 degree range which is unseasonably cold for mid-April. The weekend offered an array of weather conditions as well with clouds and high winds on Saturday to clear, bluebird skies and light breezes on Sunday. Despite the changing conditions, the bass continued to bite with 140 bass weighing a total of 294.70 lbs being brought to the scales over the two day period. Included in that number were 3 bass that eclipsed the magical 6.50 lb barrier making them eligible to win floating big bass honors. However, only one winner could prevail and that award goes to Scott Hill with a 9.11 lb behemoth being brought in on Sunday morning. Congratulations to Scott Hill on his achievement as I'm sure there were some tense moments in the boat before the bass was finally netted. Another indicator of how good the fishing was at this event showed up on Saturday as Scott Pomykal brought a solid 5 bass limit to the scales weighing in at 21.46 lbs. A multitude of baits were reportedly used and each seemed to provide plenty of strikes. The most popular baits were crankbaits, lipless crankbaits, spinnerbaits and a variety of soft plastics. The predominant pattern was fishing these baits around the grass lines in 3-6 ft of water. Now, after 3 tournaments have been completed, the race for the Top 6 and Angler-of-the-Year is already heating up with a mere 4 pounds separating 1st and 6th place! This is really shaping up to be an exciting year and a close competition.
