Hello again everyone and thanks to all that attended our recent tournament on Joe Pool. We ended up with 22 anglers trying their luck at Joe Pool which included two new members to our club. Everyone be sure to say welcome to our newest club members Jeff Harris and John Souhrada. As was expected, the fishing was good on Joe Pool with countless numbers of small fish as well as many slot fish being caught. However, as is the case on slot lakes, the winner is usually dictated by the angler who can locate and catch over the slot fish. Jack White and his partner were able to unlock the code and find big fish both days. A couple of key patterns that emerged for most anglers were a variety of small soft plastics fished in and around the numerous grass beds plus a few fish were caught on topwaters each morning. Depths that produced were varied with fish being reportedly caught from 3 to 20 ft of water. As we prepare for our next event, please remember that we are heading into the hot part of the year so bring plenty of sunscreen, water and sports drinks to avoid heat related problems.

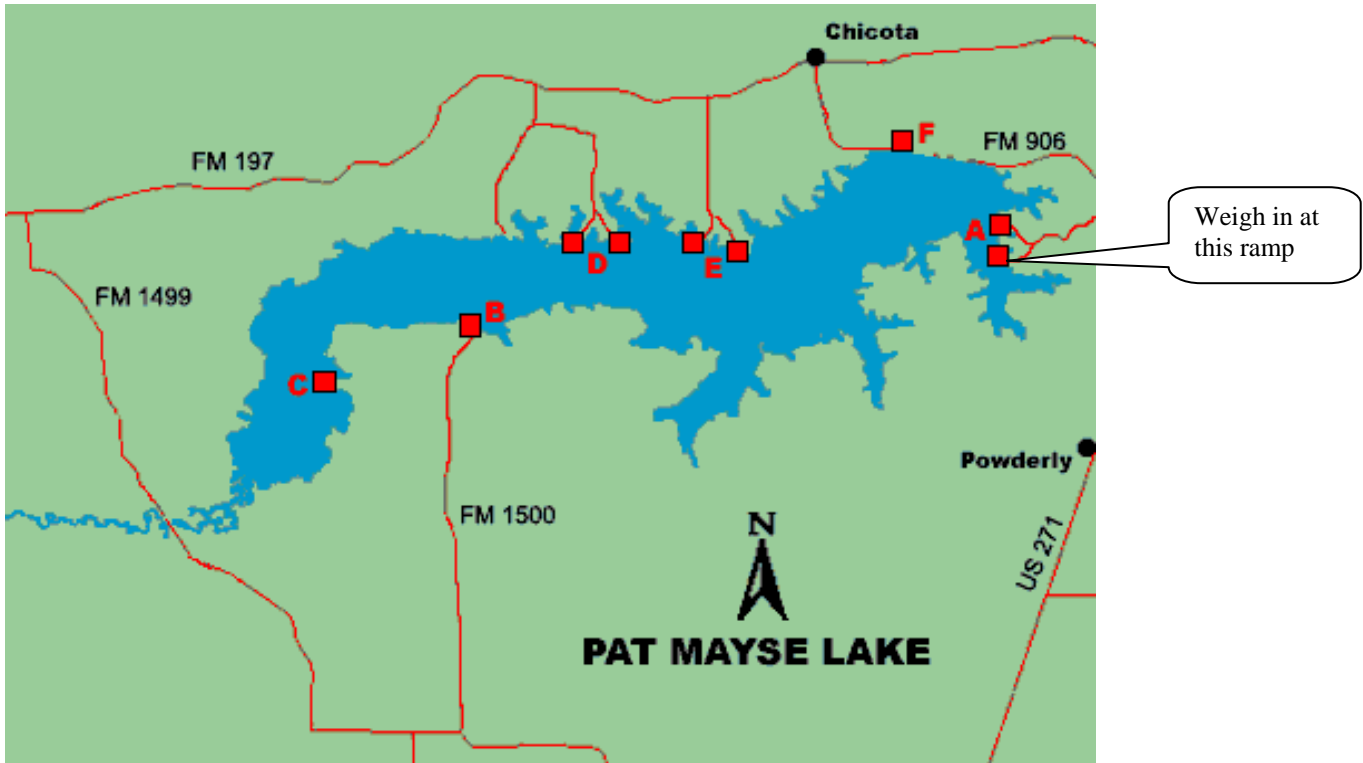
Thank you for your time and we look forward to seeing everyone at the next meeting and tournament.
